Moran ISD COVID-19 Mitigation Strategy

The purpose of this document is to provide guidance for Moran ISD with information relating to COVID-19 and recommendations for the safety of all employees, students, and their families. An accumulation of information from CDC, TEA & UIL.

DEGREE of EXPOSURE:

- **PRIMARY** – Those who have been in direct exposure with a positive tested COVID-19 individual.
 - Direct exposure is defined as having been within 6 feet of an individual testing positive for 15 minutes or greater and within 3 days of when the positive individual was showing symptoms or tested positive for COVID-19.
- **SECONDARY** – Those who have been exposed to a primary individual.
- **TERTIARY** – Those who have been exposed to a secondary individual.

ISOLATION & QUARANTINE:

- Developing symptoms and / or testing positive – stay at home for quarantining or isolation (isolation from those testing positive). Quarantined person will not be allowed back to school / work for a minimum of 14 calendar days.
- **Return to work with a positive employee / student:**
 - Your medical provider has determined a different illness than COVID-19 and / or cleared your return to work in writing.
 - OR**
 - You have 2 negative test results for COVID-19 and no symptoms
 - OR**
 - At least 10 days from the first clinical diagnosed symptom and symptoms have been gone for 3 days.
 - AND**
 - At least 72 hours fever free without fever reducing medications, Tylenol – Ibuprofen.
- **Primary Exposure** – will be sent home for 14 day quarantine, will not be allowed back to work until 14 day quarantine has been completed without symptoms emerging. This includes staff and students in an indoor classroom pod and student athlete pods for sport specific workouts where coaches have kept social distancing from athletes.
- **Secondary Exposure** – Self monitoring for 14 days after exposure to primary individuals. Self quarantine while at work and practice social distancing. Mask worn at all times when not self quarantined in the workplace.
- **Tertiary Exposure** – Same as secondary exposure.
